

**RE: PE Kits and the participation in PE lessons**

We have noticed that throughout school there are some children who are regularly forgetting their PE kits and this is having a detrimental effect on their learning as it may be that children cannot participate without the correct clothing.

Children are required to have a white t-shirt and black shorts for indoor PE and black jogging bottoms and jacket for outdoor. It is recommended that PE kits are brought to school on a Monday and left until Friday in case hall slots are changed or there are extra sporting activities taking place that week. Please note that PE Lessons are held both indoors and outdoors, throughout the year. Children should have suitable clothing to match the weather conditions.

PE is a statutory part of the curriculum and children are entitled to 2 hours of PE each week from KS1 upwards.

As a school we have been thinking of ways to help ensure that children are receiving their entitlement for PE therefore we are developing new systems to put in place to help with this. To ensure all children can actively take part in PE sessions if they do not bring PE kits from home they will be loaned a kit from school so they can still participate, however the number of kits are limited.

We really appreciate those who do bring their PE kits to school religiously and want to make sure that this does not go unnoticed, therefore children who bring their PE kits every week will be rewarded for this at the end of the school year.
