





Games:

- **Snap** – if you place a card on top of a card linked to the same country you must place your hand on the pile and say 'Snap!'. The winner is the player with all the cards at the end.
- **Pairs** – turn over the cards two at a time. You must match the country with the capital city (or whatever set you wish to play with). The player with the most pairs at the end of the game wins.
- **Hide and Seek** – hide the flags around the house. Children must retrieve the cards one at a time and match it to the correct card waiting with you.

- Increase the difficulty by choosing which set of cards you are going to play with.

 - capital city
 - continent
 - currency


Home-Work
