**Phonics:**

- RWI flash cards. Please use these to ensure that children are remembering the sounds that have been taught in school.
- Alien word cards. Used to practice reading the taught sounds in nonsense words. Similar to those used in the phonics screening.
- RWI word mats. To practise sounds and support in writing words.
- Red words word mats. These are the words that children need to learn to read and write by sight. These cannot be sounded out.
- Snakes and ladders sound board game
- Phonics screening past papers to practice

**Reading:**

- Please read a book sent from school as normal.
- Any other books that are read from your home collection can be written in your child's school diary as you would with a book brought home from school.
- reading and comprehension papers.

**Literacy:**

- Literacy activity packs to support with learning that has taken place in class.
- Writing book. Use this to keep a diary of what you have done whilst at home. Remember to focus on using capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and the conjunctions 'and, but, because, so'. The book can also be used for your child to write their own stories.

Remember to focus on using:-

- capital letters,
- finger spaces,
- full stops
- conjunction 'and, but, so, because'.
- Adjectives (description)
- School spelling booklet. Practice writing the spellings that are relevant to your child's age and what they are able to spell. Practicing these will ensure that they are used and spelt correctly more frequently during independent writing.
- Handwriting sheets to practice handwriting with.
