Team CB Trip to the Space Centre

As part of our Science topic in the upcoming summer term, I have arranged a class trip to The Space Centre. The scheduled date for this visit is Tuesday 21st April 2020. The majority of the day will be self-guided, giving the children a chance to visit a variety of galleries all relating to the Solar System and wider space, as well as the opportunity to visit the 360' planetarium where the children will be treated to an interactive show. To make the most of the day and to ensure that the children can get the best experience whilst at the centre I have also booked for the children to attend an educational workshop led by the staff at the Space Centre. Linked to our topic on Space, this session will focus on 'The Great Rocket Challenge'. The session involves the chance for students to work together to design, construct and launch a rocket which will 'land' on the Moon.

Children are to be in school for 8.10am for registration so that we can depart from school promptly at 8.30am. We will be setting off back to school at 3:30pm and hope to arrive back at school at around 5.15pm (depending on traffic). If there are any delays, we will inform you by text. School uniform should be worn.

A packed lunch will be required. Grab a bag lunches can be ordered from school at the usual cost of £2.01. Payment for this should be made to your child's dinner account on the School Gateway. Children who qualify for free school meals can order a meal using the form below.

If you haven't done so already, please inform school if your child has any allergies or medical conditions. Should your child require any medication on the day a medical form must be completed and any medication must be prescribed (including travel sickness tablets).

The cost comprises of £13 per child entry into the National Space Centre and £11 per child for the coach. A voluntary contribution of £16 per child is requested towards the cost of the visit. The cost has been subsidised by school funds and from our school fundraising monies. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received then the visit will have to be cancelled. Payments can be made through the School Gateway in full or by instalments or by cash or cheque (payable to Wombwell Park Street Primary School). If you would like your child to participate in this fantastic day of learning, would you please complete the slip below and return it to school by **Friday 6th March 2020**, along with the payment.
